1. explore the all win approach to life with the personal joy, meaning and empowerment it offers
2. consciously help create an environment in which all can thrive and see relationships flourish
3. help build a global community that works well for all, watch networks of friends grow, and experience the delight as people's lives change for the better without harming others..

The All Win Principle states...

1. All is intrinsically connected – animals, plants, human beings, and our natural environment ;
2. all and everything knows from within how best to relate to the constantly changing Universe;
3. a sustainable global community requires that we respect the ability of all to decide the course of their own lives.

These three aspects of the all win Principle form the foundation of the 30-articles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. all win relationships breed goodwill and are self-sustaining. They are capable of deflating fear and chaos and resolving global conflicts peacefully. They tend to show up the dangers inherent in structures, policies and actions which benefit some while harming others and they dissipate win/lose relationships without fuelling conflict. The all win principle is derived both from modern system's science and ancient spiritual traditions.

Our Common Vision

A world in which all can flourish in their own ways without intrinsically harming others. Our Goals To build a critical mass (bringing about a so-called Hundredth Monkey Effect) by :

- building on our combined understanding and know-how (scientific and spiritual)
- deepening our own understanding of how all win relationships work and sharing what we know with others through (self)education and research and designing curricula for schools and universities, talks/discussions/workshops; reading and writing articles, books, manuals and newsletters;
- all win think tanks;
- promoting the Universal Declaration of Human rights
- creating an environment (a morphic field) in which the empowerment and goodwill generated by all win relationships can easily reach the hearts and minds of all others.
- by working closely with like-minded organisations to consciously intensify the all win atmosphere using relevant scientific and spiritual principles.
- undertaking actions to bring about all win relationships, such as helping to implement a sustainable basic income for all which can only be spent on personal and community development; and
- lobbying the United Nations so that all Governments of the world adopt the all win principle as the norm for international decision making.

Think tanks which can generate all win solutions to global problems Handbook and seminar are available:

- A World that Works for All: an 18-month series of events carefully crafted to intensify the all win atmosphere and to dissipate that of fear policies. At present running in the Netherlands with 13 participating organisations, working closely together, sharing costs, resources and know-how. A similar event, also including businesses, is also being planned in Belgium.
